A Bill for an Act to authorise the issue from the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Federation the total sum of =N=9,120,334,988,225 (Nine Trillion, One Hundred and Twenty Billion, Three Hundred and Thirty Four Million, Nine Hundred and Eighty Eight Thousand, Two Hundred and Twenty Five Naira) only, of which, =N=530,421,368,624 (Five Hundred and Thirty Billion, Four Hundred and Twenty One Million, Three Hundred Sixty Eight Thousand, Six Hundred and Twenty Four Naira) only is for Statutory Transfers, =N=2,203,835,365,699 (Two Trillion, Two Hundred and Three Billion, Eight Hundred and Thirty Five Million, Three Hundred and Sixty Five Thousand, Six Hundred and Ninety Nine Naira) only is for Debt Service, =N=3,512,677,902,077 (Three Trillion, Five Hundred and Twelve Billion, Six Hundred and Seventy Seven Million, Nine Hundred and Two Thousand, Seventy Seven Naira) only is for Recurrent (Non-Debt) Expenditure while the sum of =N=2,873,400,351,825 (Two Trillion, Eight Hundred and Seventy Three Billion, Four Hundred Million, Three Hundred and Fifty One Thousand, Eight Hundred and Twenty Five Naira) is for contribution to the Development Fund for Capital Expenditure for the year ending on the 31st day of December, 2018.



	IACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of as follows: -	
1	(i) The Accountant-General of the Federation shall, when authorised to do so by Warrants signed by the Minister charged with responsibility for finance, pay out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Federation during the year ending on the 31st day of December 2018, the sums specified by the warrants, not exceeding in the aggregate =N=9,120,334,988,225 (Nine Trillion, One Hundred and Twenty Billion, Three Hundred and Thirty Four Million, Nine Hundred and Eighty Eight Thousand, Two Hundred and Twenty Five Naira) only.	
	(ii) The amount mentioned in subsection (1) of this section shall be appropriated to heads of expenditure as indicated in the Schedule to this Bill.	
	(iii) No part of the amount aforesaid shall be released from the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Federation after the end of the year mentioned in subsection (1) of this section.	
2	All amounts appropriated under this Bill shall be released from the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Federation only for the purpose specified in the Schedule to this Bill.	Release of funds from the Consolidated Revenue Fund

5	(i) No funds shall be paid out of the monies arising from the record specified in Section (4) except by an Act/approval of the National Assembly.	Authorization
	(ii) The Accountant-General of the Federation shall forward to the National Assembly full details of funds released to the government Agencies immediately such funds are released.
