Second Quarter, 2023

Balance of Payments

The current account deficit narrowed from KSh 206.2 billion in the second guarter of 2022 to KSh 138.7 billion in the second guarter of 2023 as presented in Table 1. The balance on merchandise trade recorded an improvement from a deficit of KSh 365.8 billion in the second quarter of 2022 to a deficit of KSh 343.2 billion in the corresponding quarter of 2023. This was attributable to a 9.6 per cent increase in exports of goods, coupled with a slight reduction in expenditure on imported commodities during the quarter under review. Tea and horticultural commodities were the key drivers in the growth of exports. The surplus from exports of services rose by 25.6 per cent to KSh 35.4 billion in the second quarter of 2023. Increased exports of services across the major categories namely; travel, transport, financial, telecommunication and government goods and services resulted to the favorable performance in international trade in services. Inflows of diaspora remittances rose from KSh 120.3 billion in the second guarter of 2022 to KSh 140.5 billion, boosting the surplus in the secondary income account by 28.2 per cent to KSh 234.5 billion in the second quarter of 2023.

The financial account net inflows rose from a surplus of KSh 199.8 billion in the second quarter of 2022 to a surplus of KSh 321.4 billion in the same quarter of 2023 largely on account of increased disbursements to general government from multilateral sources. This resulted into a build up of reserve assets by KSh 150.2 billion leading to an improvement in the overall Balance of Payments position to a surplus of KSh 152.9 billion during the quarter under review.

The Kenya shilling continued to depreciate against the greenback, exchanging at an average of KSh 137.13 to the dollar in the second quarter of 2023 compared to an average of KSh 116.32 during the second quarter of 2022.

Stock of External Debt Liabilities of General Government

The stock of external debt of general government stood at KSh 5,306.6 billion at the end of June, 2023, having risen from KSh 4,186.5 billion at the end of June,2022 as presented in Table 2. This was partly attributable to increased loan disbursements as well as valuation changes. The stock of loans from multilateral sources increased by 38.0 per cent in the second quarter of 2023 compared to the corresponding period in 2022 and accounted for 62.1 per cent of the outstanding stock of external loans at the end of June,2023. Similarly, the stock of loans from bilateral sources rose from KSh 1,105.7 billion at the end of June, 2022 to KSh 1,257.5 billion at the end of June, 2023 and accounted for 29.4 per cent of the stock of

external loans. China was the leading source of bilateral loans at the end of June, 2023. France, Japan, Italy and Germany jointly accounted for 24.0 per cent of the stock of bilateral loans during the period under review.

The stock of debt securities rose by 18.4 per cent at the end of June, 2023. The International Sovereign Bond accounted for 18.8 per cent of the outstanding stock of external liabilities at KSh 997.7 billion.

International Merchandise Trade

The second quarter of 2023 recorded an improvement in the trade balance from a deficit of KSh 429.8 billion in second quarter of 2022 to a deficit of KSh 397.8 billion, as shown in Figure 1 and Table 3. This was occasioned by a 9.6 per cent increase in exports coupled with a 1.6 per cent decrease in import expenditure. The growth in exports were largely supported by increased domestic exports of tea, horticulture, coffee, and iron and steel in the quarter under review. On the other hand, the decline in import expenditure over the same period was primarily due to decrease in imports of petroleum products, iron and steel, industrial machinery and, animal and vegetable oils.

Figure 1: International Merchandise Trade Balance, 2nd Quarter, 2021-2023



Value of Domestic Exports




Figure 2: Domestic Exports of Selected Commodities, 2nd Quarter, 2021-2023

Earnings from domestic exports in the second quarter of 2023 exhibited an increase of 6.8 per cent from KSh 170.5 billion in the corresponding quarter of 2022. This was mainly contributed by increases in earnings from domestic exports of horticultural products, tea, lubricants, and edible products and preparations as shown in Annex 1 and Figure 2. Revenue from domestic exports of horticultural products grew by 19.1 per cent in the quarter under consideration from KSh 39.4 billion recorded in the second quarter of 2022. Similarly, earnings from domestic exports of tea rose from KSh 40.3 billion in the second quarter of 2022 to KSh 43.8 billion in the second quarter of 2023, albeit the decline in export quantities in the review period. Other commodities that presented notable increases in the period under review were edible products and preparations (48.7%); petroleum products (66.8%); industrial machinery (53.3%); iron and steel (13.8%); medicinal and pharmaceutical products (26.2%); and coffee

(7.0%). In contrast, the value of domestic exports of titanium ores and concentrates shrunk from KSh 10.7 billion in the second quarter of 2022 to KSh 4.2 billion during the period under review, thus slowing down the growth of foreign exchange earnings.

Analysis by Broad Economic Category (BEC) classification showed that earnings from domestic exports were primarily from food and beverage category, which accounted for 45.1 per cent of the total domestic export earnings, as presented in Annex 7. Over the same review period, non-food industrial supplies were the second dominant category, and accounted for 26.1 per cent of the total domestic export's earnings, despite registering a marginal decline of 1.4 per cent compared to the second quarter of 2022.

Value of Imports




Figure 3: Value of Imports of Selected Commodities, 2nd Quarter, 2021-2023

During the second quarter of 2023, expenditure on imports declined to KSh 647.0 billion from KSh 657.3 billion in the same quarter of 2022, reflecting a decline of 1.4 per cent. The decline was largely occasioned by decrease in imports of petroleum products from KSh 168.3 billion in the second quarter of 2022 to KSh 148.8 billion in the quarter under review as presented in Figure 3 and Annex 3. Similarly, import expenditure on animal and vegetable oils declined from KSh 42.7 billion to KSh 31.9 billion during the review period. In addition, other commodities whose import value declined were electrical machinery and apparatus (50.9%); textile yarn, fabric, and related products (20.6%); plastics in primary and non-primary forms (12.1%); motorcycles and cycles fitted with auxiliary motors (61.7%); aircraft, associated equipment and parts (61.0%); and iron and steel (7.1%).

Conversely, expenditure on imported rice rose more than two-fold from KSh 9.4 billion in second quarter of 2022 to KSh 27.0 billion in the second quarter of 2023 while that of imported chemical fertilizers went up from KSh 7.9 billion in the second quarter of 2022 to KSh 12.7 billion. Similarly, over the same review period, the value of imported edible products and preparations; and second-hand clothing increased by 77.2 per cent and 57.9 per cent to KSh 7.2 billion and KSh 7.1 billion, respectively.

Under the Broad Economic Category (BEC) classification, expenditure on importation of food and beverage commodities registered the highest growth from KSh 67.1 billion in the second quarter of 2022 to KSh 94.4 billion in the same quarter of 2023 as presented in Annex 8. Expenditure on non-food industrial supplies, and fuel and lubricants continued to account for the bulk of the import bill, accounting for 59.0 per cent of the total import bill, inspite of exhibiting declines in the quarter under review.

Direction of International Merchandise Trade

In the second quarter of 2023, total exports amounted to KSh 249.2 billion representing a growth of 9.6 per cent from the same quarter of 2022. The bulk of the export earnings were from Africa continent valued at KSh 105.0 billion, representing 42.1 per cent of the Kenya's total export earnings in the review period, as shown in Annex 5. Notably, there was a remarkable increase in revenue from exports to this region from KSh 89.6 billion in the second quarter of 2022 to KSh 105.0 billion in the quarter under review. This improvement was largely contributed by increase in exports to Uganda (31.4%), Democratic Republic of Congo (32.2%), South Sudan (16.2%) and Somalia

which more than doubled. Uganda remained to be the single major destination of Kenya's exports, partly on account of increased domestic exports of cement clinkers, grain sorghum, salt, and lubricants in liquid form. On the contrary, over the same period, there was a drop in exports to Sudan by 59.7 per cent to KSh 712.0 million largely attributable to the disruptions caused by the ongoing conflict between Sudanese Armed Forces (SAF) and the paramilitary Rapid Support Forces (RSF) of the military government of Sudan.

Total exports to Asia rose from KSh 55.2 billion in the second quarter of 2022 to KSh 60.2 billion in the second quarter of 2023, reflecting an increase of 9.1 per cent. This improvement was largely contributed by increased domestic exports of tea to Pakistan. Despite the overall growth in exports to this region, exports to the United Arab Emirates declined by 9.8 per cent, largely resulting from decreased domestic exports of kerosene type jet fuel to this destination. On the other hand, earnings from exports to America declined by 31.6 per cent in the second quarter of 2023 from KSh 26.7 billion in the same quarter of 2022, largely on account of decrease in domestic exports of titanium ores and concentrates to the United States of America.

Expenditure on imports during the second quarter of 2023 were valued at KSh 647.0 billion reflecting a decrease of 1.6 per cent from the same quarter of the previous year, as illustrated in Annex 6. The bulk of imports during the quarter under review originated from Asia region and were valued at KSh 441.0 billion, representing 68.1 per cent of the total import bill. Value of imports from the Middle East increased marginally by 0.4 per cent due to slowdown in imports from United Arab Emirates, which decreased by KSh 4.6 billion compared to the second quarter of 2022. On Far East Asia, there was a drop in import expenditure to this region, largely contributed by significant decline in imports from India (14.7%), South Korea (44.6%) and Malaysia (30.0%). However, the value of imports from Indonesia went up from KSh 3.6 billion in second quarter of 2022 to KSh 8.4 billion in the quarter under review, largely driven by increased importation of crude palm oil and semi-finished products of iron and non-alloy steel.

During the second quarter of 2023, imports from the European Union (EU) increased from KSh 44.1 billion in the same quarter of 2022 to KSh 52.8 billion, partly due to increase in imports from Germany (41.1%) and Belgium (72.0%). Specifically, there was

in increase in imports of wheat and phosphatic fertilizers from Germany and vaccines for human medicine from Belgium. In spite of the rise in import expenditure from EU, import bill to Italy declined by 35.5 per cent to KSh 5.8 billion, largely on account of decreased imports of nitrogenous fertilizers. Notably, there was increase in imports of wheat from Russian Federation; and wheat and maize from Ukraine, driving the import bill from these two sources, in the quarter under review.

Import expenditure to the African continent increased from KSh 65.6 billion in the second quarter of 2022 to KSh 67.3 billion in the second quarter of 2023. This growth was largely supported by increase in imports of iron and steel, maize and coal from South Africa. However, there was notable decline in imports from Tanzania from KSh 15.5 billion in the second quarter of 2022 to KSh 10.8 billion in the quarter under review. This was largely attributable to decreased importation of maize and rice from this source. Remarkably, there was significant growth in import bill to the America from KSh 38.1 billion in the second quarter of 2022 to KSh 42.8 billion in the second quarter of 2023 reflecting an increase of 12.2 per cent. The rise was majorly on account of increased importation of butane gas, medicaments, laboratory reagents, fats and oils of fish and marine animals, and wheat from the United States of America.
