INSTITUTIONAL FRAMEWORK FOR THE JOINT NATIONAL AND COUNTY GOVERNMENTS CAPACITY ASSESSMENT AND RATIONALIZATION OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE PROGRAMME

IT IS notified for the general information of the public that, following the reorganization of the National Government, the end of the transition period and in order to comply with the legal provisions, the Cabinet Secretary responsible for Public Service has, in furtherance of the decision of the Summit to implement a joint capacity assessment and rationalization programme for the public service at the National and County levels of Government, establishes the following Institutional Framework for the Joint National and County Governments Programme.

INTER-GOVERNMENTAL STEERING COMMITTEE

1. There is established the Inter-Governmental Steering Committee.

2. The Inter-Governmental Steering Committee comprises of—

(a) the Cabinet Secretary responsible for Public Service;

(b) the Cabinet Secretary responsible for Devolution and Planning;

(c) the Cabinet Secretary responsible for the National Treasury;

(d) the Cabinet Secretary responsible for Interior and Co-ordination of National Government;

(e) the Cabinet Secretary responsible for Labour;

(f) the Chairperson of the Council of Governors;

(g) the Chairperson of the Public Service Commission;

(h) the Chairperson of the Salaries and Remuneration Commission;

(i) the Chairperson of the Commission for Revenue Allocation;

(j) the Chairperson of the Human Resources, Labour and Social Welfare Committee of the Council of Governors;

(k) three members of the Human Resources, Labour and Social Welfare Committee of the Council of Governors;

(l) the Chairperson of Inter-Governmental Relations Technical Committee;

(m) the Chairperson of Kenya Law Reform Commission; and

(n) the Attorney-General

3. The Cabinet Secretary responsible for Public Service and the Chairperson of the Council of Governors shall be the Co-Chairpersons of the Inter-Governmental Steering Committee.

4. The functions of the Inter-Governmental Steering Committee are—

(a) to provide vision, leadership and policy direction for the Capacity Assessment and Rationalization of the Public Service Programme;

(b) to oversee the Joint Capacity Assessment and Rationalization of the Public Service Programme; and

(c) to report on the implementation of the Capacity Assessment and Rationalization of the Public Service Programme to the Summit established under section 7 of the Inter-Governmental Relations Act, 2012.

5. The Inter-Governmental Steering Committee may co-opt other members as may be required to better perform its functions.

6. The Inter-Governmental Steering Committee shall meet at least two times in a year at such times and places as may be appropriate.

INTER-AGENCY TECHNICAL COMMITTEE

7. There is established the Inter-Agency Technical Committee.

8. The Inter-Agency Technical Committee comprises of—

- (a) the Principal Secretary responsible for Public Service;
 - (b) the Principal Secretary responsible for Devolution;
 - (c) the Principal Secretary responsible for Planning;
 - (d) the Principal Secretary responsible for Labour;
 - (e) the Principal Secretary responsible for Interior;
 - (f) the Principal Secretary responsible for the National Treasury;
 - (g) the Solicitor-General;
 - (h) the Secretary to the Public Service Commission;
 - (i) the Principal Administrative Secretary, Directorate of Public Service Management;
 - (j) the Pensions Secretary in the National Treasury;
 - (k) the Secretary to the Salaries and Remuneration Commission;
 - (l) a representative of the Council of Governors;
 - (m) a representative of County Public Service Boards;
 - (n) a representative of County Assembly Service Boards;
 - (o) a representative of the Kenya Institute of Public Policy Research and Analysis;
 - (p) a representative of the Union of Kenya Civil Servants;
 - (q) a representative of the Kenya County Government Workers Union;
 - (r) a representative of the Inter-Governmental Relations Technical Committee;
 - (s) a representative of the Kenya Law Reform Commission;
 - (t) a representative of the Trade Unions Congress of Kenya;
 - (u) two persons representing the Private Sector in Kenya appointed by the Cabinet Secretary Public Service, Youth and Gender Affairs; and
 - (v) three persons with expertise and experience in public sector restructuring appointed by the Cabinet Secretary responsible for Public Service.
9. The functions of the Inter-Agency Technical Committee are—
- (a) to provide overall management of the Capacity Assessment and Rationalization of the Public Service Programme;
 - (b) to implement the policy directions of the Inter-Governmental Steering Committee;
 - (c) to provide technical assistance to Ministries, Departments and County Governments;
 - (d) to facilitate consultation with Ministries, Departments, County Governments and Administrators of Schemes of Service for public officers affected by the Capacity Assessment and Rationalization of the Public Service Programme;
 - (e) to approve activities for the implementation of the Capacity Assessment and Rationalization of the Public Service Programme;
 - (f) to monitor and evaluate the Capacity Assessment and Rationalization of the Public Service Programme;
 - (g) to oversee preparation of the framework for the Capacity Assessment and Rationalization of the Public Service Programme which includes—
 - (i) policy guidelines;
 - (ii) principles of capacity assessment and rationalization;
 - (iii) criteria for capacity assessment and rationalization;

(iv) appeal mechanisms;

(v) institutional arrangements for the implementation of the framework for the Capacity Assessment and Rationalization of the Public Service Programme; and

(vi) monitoring and evaluation strategies.

(h) to develop a communications strategy for the Capacity Assessment and Rationalization of the Public Service Programme;

(i) to develop training and sensitization materials for the implementation of the programme;

(j) to develop an implementation plan for the Capacity Assessment and Rationalization of the Public Service Programme;

(k) oversee the appointment of a consultant where necessary and supervise consultant in the execution of the consultant's duties; and

(l) mainstream gender, youth and persons with disability concerns in the implementation of the Capacity Assessment and Rationalization of the Public Service Programme.

10. The Inter-Agency Technical Committee shall—

(a) hold meetings as may be necessary for the discharge of its functions and in any case, at least once in a month, at places and times that it shall consider proper;

(b) regulate its own procedure; and

(c) co-opt other persons as shall be required by the Inter-Agency Technical Committee for the performance of its functions.

11. (1) The Principal Secretary responsible for Public Service; and the representative of the Inter-Governmental Relations Technical Committee shall be the co-chairpersons of the Inter-Agency Technical Committee.

(2) The Principal Administrative Secretary, Directorate of Public Service Management shall be the alternate Co-Chairperson to the Principal Secretary.

INTER-AGENCY SECRETARIAT

12. There is established an Inter-Agency Secretariat which comprises of representatives from—

- (a) the State Department of Public Service;
- (b) the State Department of Planning;
- (c) the State Department of Devolution;
- (d) the State Department of Labour;
- (e) the State Department of Interior;
- (f) the National Treasury;
- (g) the Pensions Department of the National Treasury;
- (h) the Public Service Commission;
- (i) the Office of the Attorney-General and Department of Justice;
- (j) the Salaries and Remuneration Commission;
- (k) the Council of Governors; and
- (l) the Inter-Governmental Relations Technical Committee.

13. The functions of the Inter-Agency Secretariat shall be to—

- (a) co-ordinate the implementation of the decisions and directions of the Inter-Agency Technical Committee;
- (b) provide technical assistance and support to the rationalization technical committees of ministries and departments and the rationalization steering and technical committees of County Governments;
- (c) facilitate the work of a consultant;
- (d) co-ordinate and facilitate the sensitization and training activities;
- (e) receive analyzed reports and submit to Inter-Agency Technical Committee;
- (f) ensure compliance with the guidelines; and
- (g) monitor and evaluate the Capacity Assessment and Rationalization of the Public Service Programme and submit reports.

14. The Inter-Agency Secretariat shall—

(a) hold meetings as often as is necessary for the discharge of its functions;

- (b) regulate its own procedure; and
- (c) co-opt other persons as shall be required for the Inter-Agency Secretariat for the performance of its functions.

15. The Inter Agency Secretariat shall be chaired by the representative from the State Department of Public Service, Directorate of Public Service Management.

MINISTERIAL OR DEPARTMENTAL RATIONALIZATION TECHNICAL COMMITTEES

16. Each ministry or department shall establish a rationalization technical committee.

17. Each rationalization technical committee shall be responsible to the Inter-Agency Technical Committee for the overall implementation of the Capacity Assessment and Rationalization of the Public Service Programme in the ministry or department and as such shall—

- (a) undertake institutional review of the Ministry or Department;
- (b) assess skills and competencies required including determining optimal staffing;
- (c) establish existing human resource capacity in the Ministry or Department in terms of numbers and skills;
- (d) identify staff eligible for re-deployment, transfer or separation;
- (e) sensitize and train on the implementation of the programme;
- (f) submit reports to the Inter-agency Technical Committee; and
- (g) generally implement the programme in their respective Ministry or Department.

18. Each Rationalization Technical Committee comprises of—

- (a) the Principal Secretary or the Authorized Officer, as the case may be, who shall be the chairperson;
- (b) the head of the human resource department, who shall be the secretary;
- (c) heads of department;
- (d) the head of the planning unit;
- (e) the head of the finance unit;
- (f) the head of the accounting unit;
- (g) a representative of the Public Service Commission;
- (h) a representative of the State Department of Public Service; and
- (i) a consultant where necessary.

19. A Rationalization Technical Committee shall—

- (a) hold meetings as may be necessary for the discharge of its functions and in any case, at least once in a month, at places and times that it shall consider proper;
- (b) regulate its own procedure; and
- (c) co-opt other persons as shall be required by the Technical Committee for the performance of its functions.

COUNTY RATIONALIZATION STEERING COMMITTEES

20. Each County Government shall establish a County Rationalization Steering Committee to be chaired by the respective Governor and comprising of the following—

- (a) Executive Committee Members;
- (b) Chairperson of the County Public Service Board;
- (c) Chairperson County Assembly Service Board;
- (d) Union Representative;
- (e) County Commissioner;
- (f) Representative, State Department of Labour;
- (g) Representative of Inter-Governmental Relations Technical Committee;
- (h) County Attorney; and
- (i) County Secretary, who shall be Secretary to the Committee.

21. The functions of the County Rationalization Steering Committees shall be to—

- (a) provide vision, leadership and policy direction for the Capacity Assessment and Rationalization of the Public Service Programme in the County;
- (b) oversee the implementation of the Capacity Assessment and Rationalization of the Public Service Programme in the County;

- (c) work in consultation with Inter-Agency Technical Committee and prepare periodical reports to the Inter-Agency Technical Committee;

- (d) approve and implement sensitization and training programs; and

- (e) verify the lists of the staff identified for re-deployment, transfer or separation, if any.

22. The County Rationalization Steering Committee shall—

- (a) hold meetings at least once in a month for the discharge of its functions and, at places and times that it shall consider proper;

- (b) regulate its own procedure; and

- (c) co-opt other persons as shall be required by the County Rationalization Steering Committee for the performance of its functions.

COUNTY RATIONALIZATION TECHNICAL TEAM

23. Each County Government shall establish a Rationalization Technical Team which shall be chaired by the member of the relevant County Executive Committee responsible for matters relating to the County public service.

24. Each Rationalization Technical Team shall comprise of—

- (a) the chief officers of the County departments;
- (b) the Secretary to the County Public Service Board;
- (c) the Secretary to the County Assembly Service Board;
- (d) the County Co-ordinator of the Inter-Governmental Relations Technical Committee;
- (e) the County Commissioner;
- (f) a Consultant, if necessary;
- (g) the County Secretary; and
- (h) the County Director, Human Resource Management and Development who shall be the Secretary.

25. Each Rationalization Technical Team shall—

- (a) undertake an institutional review of the County Public Service;
- (b) assess the skills and competencies required in the County Government;
- (c) determine the optimal staffing for the County Government;
- (d) establish the existing human resource capacity of the County government;
- (e) identify the public officers eligible for redeployment, transfer or separation;
- (f) sensitize and train the public officers affected by the Capacity Assessment and Rationalization of the Public Service Programme;
- (g) facilitate the lead consultant at the County level;
- (h) prepare reports for consideration by the Inter-Agency Technical Committee on the Capacity Assessment and Rationalization of the Public Service Programme; and
- (i) implement the Capacity Assessment and Rationalization of the Public Service Programme in the County.

26. A Rationalization Technical Team shall—

- (a) hold at least two meetings in a year at places and times that it shall consider proper;

- (b) regulate its own procedure; and

- (c) co-opt other persons as shall be required by the Technical Team for the performance of its functions.
